VILLAGE MERCY FOUNDATIONAL EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Christ-Centered Transformation**
Jesus Christ and His Word (the Bible) are the foundation. Every aspect of the program is built on Scripture and the gospel.
 - 2. Phased Progression**
Residents journey through Foundation, Transformation, and Reentry phases over 9 months. Growth is measured, not rushed.
 - 3. Biblical Healing for Emotional Wounds**
We address deep wounds (trauma, shame, grief) through biblical care—helping men heal through Scripture, prayer, and discipleship.
 - 4. Vocational Training & Job Readiness**
Men are equipped with practical skills (agriculture, carpentry, digital literacy) and taught job readiness to rebuild their lives.
 - 5. Work Therapy**
Manual work is part of God’s design for dignity and discipline. Daily chores and projects foster responsibility and stewardship.
 - 6. Family Restoration**
We believe God redeems families. Residents will participate in counseling and reconciliation with loved ones.
 - 7. Church Integration**
Graduates are prepared to thrive within local churches, mentored by godly leaders, and rooted in biblical community.
 - 8. No Tolerance for Compromise**
Drugs, alcohol, violence, sexual immorality, and rebellion are strictly prohibited. Violations lead to discipline or dismissal.
 - 9. Daily Structure**
Each day is ordered for maximum growth: morning devotionals, group sessions, work, vocational classes, and worship.
 - 10. Graduation & Reentry**
Men who complete all phases and meet expectations will graduate in a ceremony and receive ongoing mentorship.
